#### **CALL TO WORSHIP**

Pastor: Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise!

Church: Be thankful unto Him and bless His Name! (Ps. 100:4 KJV)

All: Like Him, with pardon on His tongue, In midst of mortal pain,

Men: A glorious band, the chosen few

Women: On whom the Spirit came,

Men: Twelve valiant saints, their hope they knew,

Women: And mocked the cross and flame.

All: They met the tyrant's brandished steel, The lion's gory mane;

They bowed their necks the death to feel: Who follow in their

train?

Men: A noble army, men and boys, Women: The matron and the maid,

Men: Around the Savior's throne rejoice

Women: In robes of light arrayed.

All: They climbed the steep ascent of heav'n, through peril, toil and

pain;

O God, to us may grace be giv'n To follow in their train.

Pastor: In the Name of the Father, and the Son and the Holy Spirit!

Church: Amen! (Matt. 8:19)

Pastor: The Lord be with you! (Ruth 2:4)

Church: And also with you!

Pastor: Our Help is in the Name of the Lord!

Church: Who made heaven and earth (Ps. 124:8)

ALL SING: Psalm 98A (1&2nd Verses)
O Sing a new song to the Lord,
For wonders He has done (2x)
His right hand and His holy arm,
The victory have won (3x)

The great salvation wrought by Him, Jehovah has made known (2x) His justice in the nation's sight, He openly has shown (3x)

Pastor: Let us pray:

## **CONFESSION**

Pastor: Beloved in the Lord, let us draw near with a humble heart and confess our sins to God, our Father, imploring Him in the Name of our Lord Jesus Christ to grant us forgiveness:

Pastor: Blessed is the man against whom the Lord counts no iniquity!

Church: And in whose spirit there is no deceit. (Ps. 32:2) Pastor: I said I will confess my transgression to the Lord, Church: And You forgave the guilt of my sin. (Ps. 32:5)

Pastor: Now let us pray...
